COLOUR Blended from several vintages, it displays a deep amber colour.

NOSE The richly developed bouquet has hints of coffee and chocolate, complemented by subtle oak characters and well integrated brandy spirit.

PALATE The palate is luscious, but well balanced with the rich brandy spirit enhancing the flavour intensity of the lingering finish.
